## Course Structure

- Managing Accounting Systems

This stage last for 4 and a half months

## Qualification Aims

Students successfully completing this AAT Technician NVQ4 can, with relevant work experience, qualify fully as MAAT. Qualified AAT NVQ Technicians can progress on a fast-track route into studies for Chartered Accountant status.

## Assessments/Examinations

The course is examined by one AAT-set Simulation (assignment) and the submission of a special Project report.

## Cost/Equipment

Tuition Fee £465 - includes Simulation for CMCC

The AAT is a professional body. Students will need to arrange and pay registration and examination fees direct to the AAT.

Currently fees are:

- AAT Student Admission fee: (one off) £33
- UK Student Annual fee £72
- Exam fee per unit (one only) £46

Students will need to purchase some recommended textbooks, currently totalling approximately £40 at retail

Free tuition is available to those in receipt of certain means tested benefits or to their un-waged dependants. ## Entry Requirements

Candidates should have completed the first year of the NVQ4 programme. The course will include in-class exercises and students are expected to spend approximately 6-10 hours of personal learning time per week.
